SN/DS 5-0 Item 1 approved as submitted 1. Downtown Parking Structure presentation regarding potential locations for new structures and recommended improvements to the existing structures on Acequia by WRNS Studio. Request for an appropriation of \$10,000 from the Downtown Parking Fund for the design (including a construction estimate) for the recommended improvements to existing parking structures.

Chris Tavarez and Mike Olmos introduced the item. Sam Nunes, WRNS Studios gave the presentation and discussed the 7 options for new structures and changes to existing parking structures and responded to Council questions.

Item 2 AS/SN 4-1 (Gubler No) approve to move forward with a standalone 9-1-1- center for the City. 2. Overview of RCC Consultants Countywide Consolidated Dispatch Implementation Study and Project status.

Police Chief Colleen Mestas introduced the item. Lt. Dave Singleton, Tulare County Sheriff's Department gave the historical background of the project. Veronica McDermott, VPD Records Supervisor discussed that the County and other cities in Tulare County are no longer interested in a county-wide dispatch consolidation, but the Board of Supervisors are interested in co-locating a County/City Communications Facility and maintaining separate dispatch centers. McDermott presented the advantages and disadvantages of co-location as well as funding possibilities and next steps and asked for Council direction.

Council discussed their preferences and decided it is in the City's best interest to proceed with a standalone 9-1-1- communications center.

## **ITEMS OF INTEREST**

Mayor Link commented on the recent visit from Visalia's Sister City in Italy - Putignano and the events that took place over the past weekend.

Vice-Mayor Shuklian announced that Saturday 10/22 is Make a Difference Day in Visalia.
