# **CONSENT CALENDAR**

- 5. Authorization to read ordinances by title only.
- 6. Authorize the City Manager to execute a lease renewal with Golden State YMCA for the use of certain property located within Whitendale Park, 600 W. Beech Street, for the purpose of pre-school and child care programming.
- 7. Authorization for the City Manager to execute a Pipeline Crossing Agreement with Union Pacific Railroad to construct a pipeline to transport recycled water from the Water Conservation Plant to Valley Oaks Golf Course and Plaza Park.
- 8. Award Contract for Aviation Fuel Supplier to Air Petro Corporation to provide fuel for retail sales at the Visalia Municipal Airport.

- 9. Award the construction contract and authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement for the Santa Fe Street Pedestrian Corridor to the low bidder, DOD Construction, in the amount of \$142,494.50 and request an additional appropriation of \$27,000 from the Gas Tax fund.
- 10. Authorization to purchase three (3) 35 foot low floor CNG expansion fixed route buses from Gillig Corporation in the amount up to \$480,000 each for a total not to exceed \$1,440,000.
- 11. Notification and acceptance of the AVOID the 18 DUI grant award from the Governor's Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), and authorization for the City Manager to execute the grant agreement and appropriate \$272,000 in the General Fund for grant expenditures.
- 12. Authorize the City Manager to apply for a Public Benefit Grant from the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District to purchase five hybrid passenger vehicles. Allocate \$25,000 from the Vehicle Replacement Fund to pay for the City's match.

Authorize the City Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with Mendoza & Associates for Construction Management and Resident Engineer Services for the Plaza Drive Interchange Modification and Widening Project. Contract amount not to exceed \$1,861,871.25. Project Number 3011-00000-720000-0-9438.

- 17. Request authorization to file a Notice of Completion for Taco Bell Off-Site Sewer Extension, Site Plan Review 10-065, located at 2421 N. Dinuba Boulevard.
