Details: On 09/29/13 at 0151 hrs., a traffic stop was conducted by Visalia P.D. patrol due to the vehicle fitting the description of a suspect vehicle in a recent vehicle burglary. It was learned during the traffic stop, that the two occupants (listed above as suspects) just committed an additional vehicle burlgary and had stolen property with them. Property Crime was contacted and assisted with the investigation. It was determined that both suspects were involved with at least six (6) vehicle burglaries over the past 2-months within the City of Visalia. Both suspects are on active probation. During the search of S/Barrientos' residence; stolen property was also located from a recent vehicle burglary in the City of Visalia.
