Details: On 10/17/14 at approximately 0700 hours, Visalia Police Department SWAT Team served two search warrants in the City of Visalia as part of an investigation conducted by the Narcotics Unit. The first residence was located in the 2100 block of N. Court. After the residence was secured, a search of the residence was conducted by Narcotic Detectives and the Gang Suppression Unit. During the search of this residence, officers located methamphetamine, a digital scale, cash, packaging material and other items indicative of sales.
