Details:

On the above listed date and time, units responded to the area of Willis and School regarding an injury traffic collision. Upon arrival, it was discovered that a Yellow Honda motorcycle being ridden by Robert Cullum was northbound Willis when it collided with a gray Chrysler sedan that was traveling westbound on School Ave. at Willis. The rider of Honda motorcycle, Cullum, sustained severe injuries in the collision and was transported to Fresno Regional Medical Center where he remains in critical condition. The driver of the Chrysler sedan, Alvarez, and his infant passenger, were not injured. The cause of the collision is under investigation and being handled by the Visalia Police Department Traffic Unit.

UPDATE:

On 02/01/15 involved party Robert Cullum succumbed to his injuries while at Fresno Regional Medical Center. The investigation into the collision is continuing by the Visalia Police Department Traffic Unit.
