Filming Event Check List

	Submit a complete Special Events Application to the City of Visalia at least 60 days prior to the planned event.	
	Provide information regarding the location(s), date(s) and time(s) for each filming location.	
	For all activity within the public right-of-way, a Temporary Street Closure Permit is required.	
	0	If activity involves a complete or partial street closure, a traffic control plan is required.
	0	The City reserves the right to approve/deny any and all complete or partial street closures.
	0	Complete the Good Neighbor Policy which is to be signed by all the adjoining property owners and businesses.
	Provide and maintain insurance for the applicant and all of its subcontractors as described:	
	0	General liability in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence naming the City of Visalia as additionally insured.
	0	If employees then Worker's Compensation insurance with statutory limits, and employer's liability insurance with limits of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per incident.
	Provide a brief explanation of the event which can be used for a press release to keep the general public informed.	
	Submit any additional information that may assist with the processing of the request to use public facilities for the purpose of filming or other events.	

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
