Encroachment Permits NOTICE TO START WORK

Submit this form to the City of Visalia five (5) working days prior to the initial scheduled start of work or for work that is being restarted after being interrupted for two (2) weeks or more. **NOTE:** Based upon job location, duration, proposed phasing of work or field conditions, PCMS may be required and shall be installed: seven (7) days prior to road closures & three (3) business days prior to lane restrictions.

PERMITEE TO CONTACT CITY OF VISALIA PUBLIC WORKS INSPECTOR:

- 1. Two (2) working days minimum prior to start of work, and to schedule all necessary inspections.
- 2. Immediately upon completion of the permitted work to schedule a final inspection.

No work shall begin until the Contractor calls the assigned inspector to activate the permit and submits a detailed construction schedule and reviewed/approved by the City of Visalia.

The Encroachment Permit is issued in accordance with Section 12.12.010 of the City of Visalia Municipal Code.

NO party other than the named Permitee or the Contractor of the Permitee is authorized to work under this permit. If your Contractor(s) of Subcontractor(s) are not named in a previously approved list they will be required to apply for an encroachment permit prior to starting the work and all applicable fees shall be assessed.

The Permitee shall maintain, and shall require all subcontractors to maintain, insurance as required within the City of Visalia Encroachment Permit Policy Manual.

All Contractors, Sub-Contractors, and Developers must obtain a Business Tax License to operate a business in the City of Visalia. Business Tax Licenses can be obtained at City Hall East located at 315 E. Acequia Avenue.

It is understood and agreed by the Permitee and the Contractor that any work under this permit shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions of this permit and all attachments.

The Encroachment Permit along with the Traffic Control Plan or copies thereof shall be kept at the work site and must be shown to any representative of the City or any law enforcement officer on demand. WORK SHALL BE SUSPENDED IF PERMIT IS NOT AT JOB SITE AS PROVIDED.
