**Details:** On July 4, 2015, the Visalia Police Department responded to the 100 block of N. Court for a report of a carjacking. The investigation showed (2) victims were inside their 1990 Lexus when an unknown male suspect armed with a handgun approached on foot, ordered the victims out, and fled in their vehicle. The victims were not injured.

On 7-5-15, Officers from the department's Gang Suppression Unit conducted a routine traffic stop near Linwood and Noble and contacted known gang member S/Jose Casarez. During a search of S/Casarez' vehicle, evidence was located inside the vehicle linking him to the carjacking the night before. S/Casarez was taken into custody.

Officers also searched S/Casarez' residence in Orosi and found additional evidence of the carjacking. The 1990 Lexus was located at a different location in Orosi. S/Casarez was booked at the Tulare County Pre Trial Facility for carjacking.
