**Details:** On 1/18/16 at 0906 Hours, the Visalia Police Department was notified of threatening messages that were posted on a social media website. The threats, made by the suspect, claimed that he was going to "blow up" Mt Whitney High School. Violent Crimes Detectives were called out and took over the investigation.

The investigation revealed that the listed suspect was responsible for making the threats. At 1400 Hours, Detectives located the juvenile suspect at his residence in the City of Visalia. He was interviewed and then booked into Tulare County Juvenile Hall for Terrorist Threats (422 PC).
