On the listed date and time, Visalia Police Department patrol responded to the 300 block of W. Tulare for a report of an agitated male walking near a residence swinging a baseball bat. As officers are on foot checking the area, suspect Troy Cleffman exits his residence and begins yelling at officers. Officers attempt to begin a diologue with Cleffman. Suspect Cleffman enters his residence after warning officers he was returning with a gun.

A short time later, Cleffman exits the residence and points an object at an officer. An officer fired his handgun striking the suspect one time in the arm. The suspect was then taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for treatment. He remains in police custody. The object was later found to be a large, dark colored machete. The Tulare County Sheriff's Office is handling this officer involved shooting. No officers were injured in the incident. The investigation is continuing.
