
Proactive Time

- If only responding to calls, cannot do proactive policing (Crime Prevention & Traffic Enforcement)
- Officers per Thousand Ratio (US DOJ recommended ratio is 1.9)
 - Officer positions grow with population
 - 140 sworn staff to a population of 130,753 is 1.07 officers per 1,000 population
 - Plan seeks to attain between a ratio of 1.2-1.33 officers per 1,000 population
- Time when no units are available
 - If no units are available for call, Police services suffer


Calls for Service to Population Growth

2013 PATROL WORKFORCE STUDY FINDINGS

Staffing

- Adequate for handling Calls For Service
- Recommended unobligated time for proactive policing (40 to 50% of time)
- 23 officers needed to reach this target (obligated vs. proactive)

Average response time

- Calls For Service 2013: 15.1 min. 2015: 19.3 min.

- Priority 1 Calls 2013: 5.6 minutes 2015: 6.3 min.

- On-scene time 2013: 18.9 minutes 2015: 14.5 min.
