**Details:** On above listed date and time, officers responded to the area of Myrtle and Conyer for a call for service from a resident in the area who saw suspicious subjects entering parked vehicles. Upon arrival, officers checked the area and the two listed juvenile suspects attempt to flee from officers on foot. An officer diligently searching the area was able to locate and detain the suspects in the area of College and Dollner. Investigation found that the two suspects had entered multiple vehicles from the downtown area to the area of Myrtle and Conyer, and stole property. Victims positively identified their stolen property that was located on the suspects. Both suspects were arrested for possession of stolen property, resisting arrest and booked into juvenile hall.
