Details: During the past week, the Visalia PD Property Crimes Unit began an investigation into several residential burglaries where a red Honda CRV was listed as the suspect vehicle. On 02/28/17, Detectives located that vehicle in the 300 block of NE 4th. Detectives followed the SUSPECT in that vehicle to another location and arrested him in connection with a residential burglary. CERVANTES is on early release from prison and on Probation.
