Details: On February 13, 2018 at 1000 hours members of the Visalia Police Department Special Enforcement Bureau and the Tulare Police Department Crime Specific Unit served a search warrant in the 300 block of South I Street in the City of Tulare. During the search, officers located 27 grams of heroin, 2 grams of methamphetamine, scales, packaging materials, a firearm, a high capacity magazine and \$3,300 in US currency. It was also discovered that Suspect Baltazar was committing a felony while out on bail from a previous narcotic related arrest. Suspect Baltazar was booking into the Tulare County Pretrial Facility on the above listed charges.
