Details: At the above listed date/time, officers responded to a residence in the 2100 block of N. Turner in regard to a family disturance involving a male suspect stabbing another person at this residence. Upon officers arrying, they encountered an uncooperative male subject armed with a knife. Officers utilized less lethal shotgun bean bag rounds; however, they were ineffective, resulting in an officer involved shooting. Both the victim and suspect were transported to a local hospital, where they are being treated for non-life threatening injuries. The Tulare County Sheriff's Department took over the investigation. An updated press release will follow, pending further investigation.
