Details: On August 2nd 2018, detectives from the Visalia Police Department Violent Crimes Unit, Property Crimes Unit, and Youth Services Unit, conducted a search warrant at Cali Ink, located on the 100 block of S. Locust. The search warrant was the result of a month long investigation into Michael Snitzer who had been identified as having inappropriate sexual contact with a minor. The investigation identified two additional adult victims that were sexually assaulted by Snitzer. During the course of the investigation, Snitzer was also found to be in possession of Child Pornography and had exchanged inappropriate material with a juvenile.
