Details: On 11/10/18 at approximately 2205 hours the Visalia Police Department received a report of an injury hit and run traffic collision in the area of Ben Maddox and Noble. At approximately 2207 a second injury hit and run traffic collision was reported in the area of Lovers Lane and Mineral King. Following the second report a citizen contacted the communications center and advised they were following the suspect vehicle in the area of Douglas and Palm. Officers quickly arrived in that area and located the suspect vehicle and conducted an enforcement stop. The subsequent investigation revealed that the same vehicle was responsible for both collisions. A third collision was located at Pinkham and Noble which resulted in property damage only. The investigation into that collision is ongoing. The driver has been identified at 23 year old Henry Raygoza Jr of Dinuba. S/Raygoza was booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-trail Facility for felony DUI, and felony hit and run. The occupants of the other vehicles suffered minor to moderate injuries and are all expected to recover.
