Details: On April 1st 2020 at 9:30 pm officers responded to the 800 block of N. Court for a subject that was in the middle of the roadway attempting to stop traffic. As the first officer arrived on-scene he observed the suspect, later identified as Bradley Williams running in the roadway. The suspect ran over to the officer's car and punched the window, breaking it. As other officers arrived on-scene the suspect began to attack them at which time a Taser was deployed. The suspect continued to violently resist the officers at which point a K-9 was deployed and the suspect was taken into custody. The suspect was found to have two outstanding warrants for resisting arrest out of Kings County. The suspect was later booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trail Facility for charges of resisting arrest, felony resisting arrest with violence, vandalism, and his outstanding warrants after being medically cleared.
