Details: On April 18, 2020 at 7:51 AM, Officers responded to the 1900 Block of E. Mineral King for a vehicle theft that just occurred. While en route to the location, Officers located the vehicle and attempted a traffic stop. The Suspect, Bruce Woodworth, failed to yield. After a short pursuit, he abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. Officers were able to locate him a short time later; utilizing a K9 he was taken into custody.
