Details: On April 20th at approximately 2309 hours an officer with the Visalia Police Department observes a vehicle fail to stop for a red light at Dinuba and Ferguson at a high rate of speed. The vehicle continues at a high rate of speed. The officer caught up to the vehicle near downtown Visalia and the driver failed to yield. Following a short pursuit the suspect vehicle became disabled at Mineral King Ave and Locust St. The driver was taken into custody without further incident. The suspect in this case was identified as Yumiko Nava (26) of Visalia. Nava was booked at the Tulare County Adult Pretrial Facility for felony evading.
