**Details:** On June 6, 2020 at approximately 2230 hours a witness observed a stolen vehicle traveling in the area of Demaree and Mineral King. The witness followed the vehicle to Demaree and Ferguson where officers attempted to make a traffic stop. The vehicle failed to yield and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit ended at Kayenta and Riggin when the vehicle became disabled. One suspect was detained inside the vehicle and three other suspects fled on foot into a nearby neighborhood. A perimeter was set up and all three suspects were located and arrested. The four suspects were booked at the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Facility for Possession of Stolen Property and Resisting Arrest.
