DUI Collision with injuries - Santa Fe S/of Tulare - Single Vehicle -v- Tree

Patrol Officers respond to a single vehicle collision and find a white Chrysler 300 N/B Santa Fe has collided with a parked vehicle on the west side of the road. The Chrysler driven by Lopez then crosses the road and collides with a tree. 5 additional passengers were in the Chrysler, and all were transported for medical attention. 3 were treated and released, 2 remain hospitalized for serious injuries. Driver Lopez was arrested for DUI causing injury. He was booked after medical clearance. Speed was also a factor in the collision.
