Details:

On 06/10/21 at approximately 1545 hours, officers with the Special Enforcement Unit conducted a traffic stop for speeding and failure to use a turn signal. The driver, Matthew Tillery (34), was found be unlicensed with a warrant for his arrest. The front passenger, Matthew Esparza (28) was found to be on probation with search terms associated with his probation status. Esparza was also found to have 8 warrants for his arrest. A search of the vehicle was conducted. A loaded and unserialized 9mm handgun was located in the glove compartment. Both Esparza and Tillery were taken into custody and transported to Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility.
