## **Details:**

On July 30, 2021, at 4:36 PM officers were dispatched to Motel 6, 4645 W. Noble for a report of a subject brandishing a firearm. The Victim told officers an unknown male subject came to the door and after a verbal altercation the male pointed a gun at him. Officers found the male, Benjamin Contreras, in a parked vehicle. Contreras and a passenger, Osvaldo Rodriguez, were detained without incident. A loaded firearm, narcotics and drug paraphernalia were located inside of the vehicle. Contreras was arrested for brandishing a weapon, felon in possession of a firearm/ammunition and narcotics related charges. Rodriguez was also arrested on narcotics related charges. They were booked at Tulare County Pre-Trial Detention Facility.
