Details: The Visalia Police Department is asking for the public's help in locating a missing and endangered elderly male adult.

On 11-20-21 at approximately 2:15 p.m. the Visalia Police Department was dispatched to the 1900 block of S. Burke St. regarding a missing and endangered adult. Nieves Ramirez, 77 years of age, walked away from his residence and was last seen wearing a lightweight black jacket, blue jeans, a green shirt, and white and black shoes. He is described as a Hispanic Male adult 5'03" tall, weighing 155 pounds, with white short hair and brown eyes. Mr. Ramirez walks with a limp and suffers from several health conditions, including dementia. He was last seen in the area of the Transit Center located at Bridge and Center on 11-18-21.

Detectives with the Visalia Police Department are currently working this case and a Silver Alert has been initiated with the California Highway Patrol. Anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Mr. Nieves Ramirez are asked to contact the Visalia Police Department at 559-734-8117.
