Details: On 1/31/22 at 9:40 a.m. the Target on south Mooney Blvd. in the City of Visalia was burglarized, and a large amount of electronics were taken. On 2/2/22 an additional burglary occurred at the Target located in the City of Tulare. During the investigation, detectives from the Visalia Police Department Property Crimes Unit were able to identify Suspect Gary Redfearn (40), from Bakersfield, as the suspect. Redfearn is on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) out of Kern County for burglary.

An arrest warrant was authorized and on 2/16/22, Detectives from the Visalia Police Department Property Crimes Unit, Kern County Probation Department, and Bakersfield Police Department contacted Redfearn at his apartment in Bakersfield. (S) Redfearn was taken into custody without incident. During a search of his apartment, Detectives located electronics taken during the two commercial burglaries.

Redfearn was booked into the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility on two counts of commercial burglary.
