## **Chief Salazar Announces Sergeant Promotions**

Chief Jason Salazar announces the promotions of Agent Blake McEwen and Agent Jacob Sorensen to the position of Police Sergeant.

In 2008, Sergeant Blake McEwen was hired by the Visalia Police Department as a Police Officer. Blake has held various assignments including Patrol, Crisis Intervention Training Officer, Explorer Advisor, Youth Services Officer, Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVOC) Instructor, Mobile Field Force member, Background Investigator, and as a Detective for the Property Crimes Unit.
