#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC OUTREACH MEETING

The City of Visalia Historic Preservation Advisory Committee (HPAC) will hold a public outreach meeting on <u>Wednesday March 30, 2022, at 5:30pm. The meeting will be held</u> <u>at the City Council Chambers, located at 707 West Acequia Avenue, in Visalia CA.</u> The HPAC and city staff will be present to share information and solicit public comment for two projects affecting properties located within the Historic District and/or on the Local Register of Historic Structures. The projects are listed below as follows:

- 1. An update to Visalia Municipal Code Chapter 17.56, the Historic Preservation District Ordinance. The ordinance update proposes revisions to:
  - HPAC reviews of structures on the Local Register, located outside the Historic District;
  - HPAC reviews of demolition requests;
  - HPAC reviews of fencing requests;
  - Limitations on paving within front yard setback areas;
  - o Changes to the frequency of Local Register surveys; and
  - Addition of definitions for Local Register classifications;
- 2. A comprehensive update to the Local Register of Historic Structures. The project involves the surveying of properties on the Local Register, and reclassification or removal based on the condition and context of the structures on each site. (Note: Surveys of properties on the Local Register were completed in October 2021).

You are invited to attend the meeting, ask questions, and express your views on the projects listed above. Comments collected from the public will be incorporated into the projects and shared with the Visalia Planning Commission and Visalia City Council upon review.


## **HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE**

- Visalia Municipal Code Chapter 17.56.
- Historic Preservation Advisory Committee.
- Promotion of Visalia's cultural heritage through preservation of historic structures/sites.
- Accomplish primarily through:
  - Review of building/zoning actions;
  - Updates to the Local Register;
  - Nomination of sites to State/Federal Historical Registers.

# **LOCAL REGISTER CLASSIFICATIONS**

- Exceptional:
  - Properties with preeminent historical significance, considered for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.
- Focus:
  - Properties having significant value, of good to excellent quality, considered for local recognition and protection.
- Background:
  - Properties that may not be historically significant/unique, but which contribute positively to the "visual fabric" of Visalia.

# **LOCAL REGISTER UPDATE**

- Ordinance requires an annual review of the Local Register.
- Can involve site visits, reclassifications, additions, and deletions to Local Register.
- Last update in 2013.
- Project began in 2021, sites visits conducted.
- Focus is on determining appropriate site classifications.

### HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE UPDATE

- HPAC was requested to recommend Ordinance revisions.
- City Council Work Sessions 10/2021, 2/2022.
- Direction to pursue specific revisions, conduct public outreach.



### HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE UPDATE

- 1. Update Ordinance so "Background" Local Register structures located <u>outside</u> the Historic District are subject to HPAC review.
- 2. Grant HPAC the ability to deny demolition requests for any property within the Historic District or Local Register.
- 3. Add definitions for Local Register classifications to the Ordinance.

### HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE UPDATE


- Add specific criteria for the evaluation of fencing proposals.
- 5. Limit the percentage of paved surfaces allowed within front yard areas.

6. Change the frequency of Local Register reviews.



# **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- Both projects must be approved by the HPAC, Planning Commission, and City Council.
- All hearings will be noticed and open to the public.
- April to August, 2022.
