Details: On 7/10/22 at approximately 11:24 p.m., officers with the Visalia Police Department responded to the 2600 block of S. Bollinger St. for a report of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival, officers learned that Suspect Conrad Madrid was involved in a domestic disturbance where he had assaulted his girlfriend causing visible injuries and had fled the scene prior to the officer's arrival. The investigation of this incident led officers to obtain an arrest warrant for (S) Madrid.

On 7/11/22 at approximately 12:55 p.m., (S) Madrid returned to the residence where he was involved in an additional disturbance. Officers responded to the scene and upon arrival (S) Madrid fled into a detached structure in the backyard. (S) Madrid refused to come out of the structure despite officer's orders. The Visalia Police Department Crisis Negotiating Team later arrived on the scene and began negotiations with (S) Madrid however, he continued to refuse to exit.

The Visalia Police Department SWAT Team responded and made entry into the structure where (S) Madrid was taken into custody without incident. There were no injuries to officers or to (S) Madrid. (S) Madrid was later transported to the TCSO Pre-Trial Facility where he was booked on an active warrant for domestic violence and obstructing/delaying/resisting.
