*******BACKGROUND*****

On December 13, 2020, at 7:59 P.M., patrol officers were dispatched to the area of Ruiz Park at 639 E. Buena Vista Ave. in Visalia regarding a shooting that had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers located one victim suffering from a single gunshot wound. The 15-year-old victim was taken to a local hospital and died as a result of his injuries seven days later.



The Visalia Police Department and the California Department of Justice (DOJ) Special Operations Unit (SOU) partnered and conducted an extensive investigation into the murder. The collaborative work of these agencies, along with informational tips from the public, assisted the Visalia Police Department Violent Crimes Unit in identifying seven suspects for their involvement in the homicide.

On February 21st, 2023, at approximately 6:00 A.M., the Visalia Police Department SWAT Team, the Tulare County Sheriff's Office SWAT Team, and the California Department of Justice (DOJ) Special Operations Unit (SOU) served a series of search warrants in the City of Farmersville and in the City of Visalia. The investigation resulted in a total of six search warrants being served, producing seven arrests and the seizure of six handguns, one shotgun, and approximately \$10,000 in cash.

The below listed suspects were arrested and booked on the following charges:

Antonio Castaneda – Homicide Candelaria Ramos – Accessory to Homicide and Felony Conspiracy Jennifer Ruiz-Castaneda – Conspiracy Jose Ramos-Castaneda – Accessory to Homicide and Felony Conspiracy Jose Patricio Ramos Jr. – Accessory to Homicide and Felony Conspiracy Maria Griselda-Campos – Resisting, Delaying, Obstructing an Officer Male Juvenile- Accessory to Homicide and Felony Conspiracy.
