Man Behind Bars for Vandalism, Resisting Arrest and Preventing Victim from Calling 9-1-1

Just after 2:00 p.m, VPD Officers were called to Perez Law Firm in the 1300 block of West Center Avenue for a client vandalizing the business. When officers arrived on scene, they contacted 34-year-old Juan Manzano.

Manzano refused to comply with the officers and became physical with them. Officers deployed their taser and the suspect was taken into custody. No injuries were sustained.

Throughout the investigation, officers found that Manzano caused approximately \$5,000 worth of damage to the business, threatened an employee, and physically stopped another employee from calling 911.

He was booked at the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility for felony vandalism, criminal threats, resisting, and damaging a communication device to prevent help.
