Mary Beatie from TPG Consulting reviewed two alternative concepts and the possibility of a hybrid plan that would include no road closures but the addition of traffic and pedestrian modifications as well as improvements to the park.

Councilmember Collins highlighted the project's potential to recharge groundwater and potentially reduce flooding.
