1. Introduction of Interim VUSD Superintendent – Stan Carrizosa, Superintendent. Superintendent Carrizosa introduced Interim Superintendent Dr. Craig Wheaton and thanked the City Council for their working relationship.

2. City of Visalia and VUSD Budget Updates – Eric Frost, Administrative Services Director City of Visalia and Christine Statton, CFO VUSD.

Eric Frost, Administrative Services Manager, reported the City's General Fund budget for 2010/11 has a \$2.5 million deficit and the Council will consider alternatives for bridging the deficit. The City's budget of \$60 million, \$8.5 million has been cut over the last two fiscal years, leaving Visalia

with a \$52 million General Fund Budget.

Christine Statton, Chief Financial Officer, VUSD, provided a summary of the Governor's proposed state budget and its effect on VUSD, as well as the ongoing process of balancing the district budget resulting from prior year state budget reductions. Statton reported the district is deficit spending \$16 million in 2009-10.

Paul Scheibel, Planning Division, discussed the General Plan Update and the process for outreach to the community, The Update is expected to be a 3-year process with completion tentatively scheduled for December 2012. Scheibel responded to questions.
