<u>Details:</u> On 07-03-12 at 1745 hours, two unknown Suspects broke into the Victim's residence, while he was away from his residence. Suspects made off with some of the Victim's property.

On 07-04-12, detectives from the Property Crimes Unit were assigned the case to investigate.

On 07-06-12, through the course of the investigation, detectives determined that the above Suspects were responsible for the burglary and took them into custody without incident.

Detectives served Search Warrants at the Suspects residences and located some of the Victim's property as well as other property that was stolen from the City of Farmersville.

Both Suspects were booked into the Tulare County Jail for burglary, gang member in possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony, gang enhancement, conspiracy and for possession of stolen property.
