Details: On 05/17/12, the Visalia Police Department responded to a reported burglary at the Salvation Army. It was reported that an unknown subject had forced their way into the building and taken over \$20,000 worth of electronic equipment from the Salvation Army. Evidence was collected from the scene by Visalia Police Department Crime Lab.

On 12/11/12, Property Crimes Detectives were able to confirm evidence from the scene, implicated a 16 year old juvenile male suspect. The juvenile was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Facility. The investigation is ongoing.
