Details: On 5-1-13 the Visalia Police Department received a report of a burglary and a stolen vehicle from a residence in the City of Visalia. On 5-2-13 Tulare County Sheriff's Deputies located the stolen vehicle in the town of Cutler and detained 4 suspects. Investigators from the Tulare County Reduce Auto Theft Taskforce (T-RATT) and Visalia Police Department Property Crimes Unit conducted the investigation and found that the suspects were in possession of stolen property and were responsible for the residential burglary and auto theft. Suspects were arrested for charges of residential burglary, auto theft, possession of a stolen vehicle, and possession of stolen property.
