Details: On April 18, 2014 at approximately 2:00 A.M., Visalia Police Department Officers were dispatched to an audible alarm in the 4100 block of W. Noble. Upon arrival Patrol Officers discovered that Cigarettes 4 Less was burglarized along with a neighboring business, Malintze Gutierrez D.O.'s office. Property located at the scene was later discovered to be property stolen from a vehicle burglary that occurred in the 4800 block of W. Noble. The Visalia Police Department Property Crimes Unit conducted further investigation and identified Salvador Parsels as the person responsible for the listed burglaries. Property from the burglaries was recovered and suspect Salvador Parsels was booked into the Tulare County Jail for two counts of commercial burglary and one count of vehicle burglary.
