Details: On 8/20/14 at approximately 1000 hours, Visalia Police Department Narcotics Detectives, the Gang Suppression Unit and California State Parole conducted a parole search at the residence of (S) Joel Madrigal who was on active parole. During the search, officers located approximately 4 pounds of methamphetamine and approximately 6 ounces of cocaine. Also located was over \$2000 in currency, packaging material and two digital scales.
