Details: On 12/23/14 at approximately 1200 hours members of the Visalia Police Department Gang Suppression Unit responded to an address in the 25000 block of Road 204 in Exeter, Ca for a probation search. The occupant at the residence is a known gang member. Upon arrival Suspect Diaz ran from the residence and evaded capture. Suspect Santos was located near the residence and detained. During the search officers located 4 firearms, 2.5 grams of meth packaged for sales, 29.4 pounds of marijuana, and numerous items indicative of the sales of narcotics. S/Santos was booked into the Tulare County Jail for numerous charges. S/Diaz is currently being sought by the Visalia Police Department for numerous felony charges.
