**Details:** On the listed date and time, the Visalia Police Department responded to the area of Highway 198 and Lovers Lane regarding a vehicle driving recklessly in the area. The vehicle was not located. A short time later, officers responded to the 1600 block of E. Douglas for a report of a single vehicle collision into an apartment carport matching the description of the reckless vehicle report. Upon arrival on E. Douglas, officers found a 2013 Ford Edge had driven through a wall of a carport and struck two parked vehicles. Officers were told the male driver walked away to a nearby residence.

Officers located the driver, S/Zavala, at this residence and arrested him without incident. There were no injuries reported. The vehicle S/Zavala was driving was reported stolen out of Porterville, CA. S/Zavala was booked into the Tulare County Pre Trial Facility for auto theft, driving under the influence, and misdemeanor hit and run.
