Cape Seal Project in Downtown Visalia

Cape Seal pavement maintenance projects are active throughout the City with work taking place between 7:00 am – 5:00 pm on posted streets.

This project will be in Downtown Visalia on Main Street applying a Micro Seal on Sunday, August 16th and Monday, August 17th between the hours of 8:00 pm and 6:00 am. Main Street will be treated between Conyer St. on the west and Garden Street on the east. The work is being done overnight to minimize any impact to businesses in the area. (See attached maps and street listing for detailed information on the project.)

Main Street will receive a micro surfacing treatment that consists of an asphalt emulsion and aggregate and will require 4 to 5 hours to dry and be ready for traffic.

To minimize any inconvenience from this project, citizens are advised to:

- Observe all No Parking signs posted on Main Street.
- Drive slow to prevent pick up of any residue.
- Residue on vehicles can be removed with immediate washing with soap and water.
