Details: On 2/13/16 at 1554 hours members of the Visalia Police Departments Special Enforcement Unit conducted a traffic stop in the area of Mooney and Houston in the City of Visalia. Upon contact a male passenger was discovered to have approx. 2 ounces of methamphetamine on his person. As the officer attempted to take him into custody the suspect began to fight the officer and was able to break free. After a moderate foot pursuit the suspect was arrested. The vehicle involved fled the scene once officers began the foot pursuit. The suspect was identified as Ruben Mendoza. S/Mendoza was booked for possession and transportation of narcotics for sales, and resisting arrest with force or violence.

During the foot pursuit a second suspect identified as Marco Chavez believed officers were there for him and began jumping fences. He was contacted by perimeter units and found to have ½ ounce of methamphetamine on his person. He was arrested for possession of narcotics for sales. Both suspects were booked into the Tulare County Pre-trial Facility.
