Details: On the listed date and time, the Visalia Police Department responded to a report of a male armed with a handgun on the Golden Oak Elementary School campus. Upon initial arrival, it was reported this male was behind Golden Oak Elementary with potential access to several other schools. As a precaution, Golden Oak Elementary School, and nearby Riverbend School, Valley Oak Middle School, Golden West High School, and Visalia Adult School were locked down while officers conducted a thorough search of each campus. A CHP helicopter was called and assisted with this search of the school campuses and surrounding areas.

Age:

At approximately 1120 hours, all school facilities had been searched with no suspect located. School lockdowns were then lifted and surrounding streets opened. No arrests have been made.
