Details:

On the listed date and time, the Visalia Police Department responded to Jacob and Allen for a report of a traffic collision. The investigation showed a 2001 Saturn sedan driven by I/P Salas, was traveling S/B on Jacob when it struck pedestrian (Jane Doe) who was crossing Jacob Street westbound just south of Allen. The pedestrian has been identified; however her identity is being withheld pending notification of family members. Pedestrian Jane Doe suffered major head trauma and was transported by ambulance to KDMC and later transferred to Fresno Regional Medical Center where she remains in critical condition. Salas, the driver of the Saturn was not injured. Drugs or alcohol are not suspected to be involved in this collision.

The investigation into the cause of this collision is continuing and being handled by the Visalia Police Traffic Unit.
