**Details:** On 12/10/16 at approximately 2:00 AM, officers were dispatched to suspicious circumstances on the 3600 block of W. Hillsdale. A witness advised hearing a disturbance occurring in one of the apartments and seeing a man who did not reside there inside the residence. Upon arrival of the officers, they located a shattered sliding glass door and heard a male subject inside of the residence who refused to come out. When officers entered the residence, they located the suspect, Brian Walker, who was found sitting in the bathtub. When officers attempted to arrest the Brian Walker, he physically resisted but was eventually taken into custody. Brian Walker was booked at Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility for Residential Burglary and Resisting Arrest.
