Details: After a one month investigation, members of the Visalia Police Department Narcotics Unit along with the Special Enforcement Unit served a search warrant in the 300 block of W Oakland in Farmersville. During the service of the warrant, officers located 14 ounces of Methamphetamine, \$2,100 in cash, packaging materials and other items related to narcotic sales.
