Details: On the listed date and time, Visalia Police Department patrol officers responded to a residence in Visalia regarding a possible threats report. Officers learned (2) male juveniles had made threats of gun violence towards Redwood High School via the social media app SnapChat. Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit responded and took over the investigation. At approx. 0500 this morning, detectives located both juveniles at their residence and took them into custody without incident. Both were booked into Juvenile Hall. Visalia Unified School District staff was notified and is assisting with this investigation.
