

At Curbside

Place your split container within one (1) foot of your curb so it may be picked up by the garbage truck's lifting mechanism.



The garbage truck lifts your container and turns it upside down over the truck.



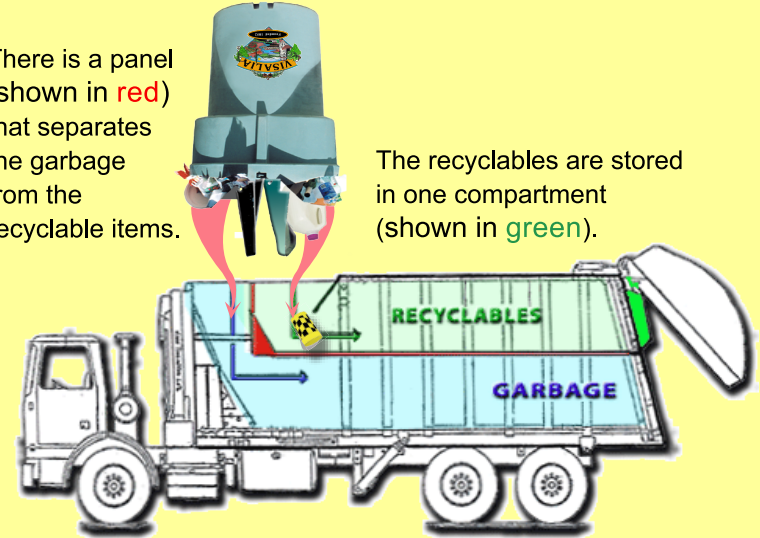
SPLIT CAN COLLECTION SYSTEM

Separating Recycled Items from Garbage

The Inside of the Truck Looks Like the Photo Below . . .

There is a panel (shown in red) that separates the garbage from the recyclable items.

The recyclables are stored in one compartment (shown in green).



The garbage is stored in the other compartment (shown in blue).

The Landfill

The truck's next stop is the landfill where the outer rear door of the truck is tilted up so that garbage from the bottom compartment empties.



To prevent the recyclable items from falling out, another door, underneath the outer rear door, stays tightly closed

The Recycling Center

At the recycling center, the outer rear door of the truck is raised and the rear of the truck is tilted up again.



This time, the inner door is opened so that the recyclables come out.
