Jugfest Traffic Control Information

On Saturday June 3rd, 2017, the annual Jugfest event will be held at Mooney Grove Park, 27000 S. Mooney Boulevard in Visalia. The following is traffic related information to assist the public.

Road closures for this event will start at 7 AM on Saturday morning and will remain in effect until the event is over at approximately 10 PM. Here is a list of the following road closures or detours.

There will be no access to Mooney Grove from the east side of the park. The road will be closed to through traffic at Ave 271 and Oakmore Way. Only residents who live west of this closure and east of the park will be permitted to pass. There will be a second closure at the east side of the park preventing any further westbound traffic. The area between the closures is posted no parking tow away zone and any cars parked in this area are subject to citation and tow.

Access to the park will all be on Ave. 272 eastbound from Mooney Blvd. Ave 272 will be converted to a one way east bound roadway for both lanes to accommodate the heavier than normal traffic flow. This will be the only public access.

Traffic coming from the south is encouraged to remain in the #2 lane (right lane) until turning on to Ave 272 eastbound.

Traffic coming from north of the park will be required to travel south to Ave 264 where U-Turns will be permitted then travel n/b back to the park before making an eastbound turn onto Ave 272.

Mooney Blvd and Ave. 272 are posted no parking anytime and a tow away zone. Parking is also prohibited at the Government Plaza Building.
