Details: On 6/5/2017 at approximately 1400hrs the Visalia Police Department responded to the area of Walnut/Chinowth to the report of a missing person. Upon arrival it was learned that Eunice Collins, 83, was not at her home, and had not been seen since Saturday 6/3. Officers were advised that she suffers from an illness requiring medication and that she does not have her medicine with her Eunice Collins is described as a white female adult.
